The Challenge

Selling into 27 markets means 27 rule books all changing at once.

The client's software is used by hotels and accommodation providers across the European Union.

Every market sets its own rules on e-invoicing mandates, fiscal and point-of-sale requirements, and tax reporting and those rules change constantly, often with hard deadlines and little warning.

Staying compliant meant someone manually checking dozens of government and tax-authority websites across more than twenty languages, written in dense legal language and hoping to spot the change before a deadline turned into a problem.

It was slow, reactive, and fragile. A single missed mandate could leave the product non-compliant in an entire country, triggering a scramble, a build, and real regulatory exposure. The team needed to stop hunting for changes and start being told about them.

40+ sources. 27 countries. Checked by hand.

Before Royyk, keeping current meant trawling government portals one by one — never knowing if something had quietly changed overnight.

1 Monitor

40+ official government, tax-authority and e-invoicing sources are scanned automatically every day across 27+ countries.

2 Detect

The platform fingerprints every page and flags the moment any source changes — no human checking required.

3 Interpret with AI

Each change is read by AI and rewritten as a plain-language alert: what changed, who it affects, the deadline, and the recommended action.

4 Alert

A prioritised notification lands in the team's Slack the instant it matters — critical changes can't be missed.

5 Ask

Anyone can ask the built-in assistant a plain-English question like "what are Poland's e-invoicing rules?" and get an instant, sourced answer.
